Hope everyone had a good time at our Dutch Oven cookout on the 25<sup>th</sup> of August. Thanks go out to our Senior Warden for putting it all together.

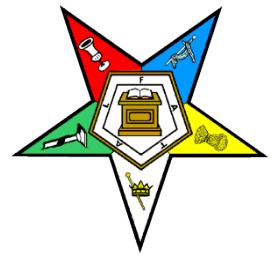
